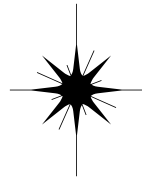


PORTLAND WINTER LIGHT FESTIVAL

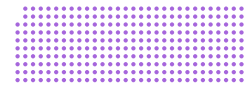

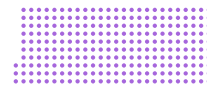
